547.5(c)(4)	The testing laboratory's written report certifies that the operation of each player interface must not be compromised or affected by electrostatic discharge, liquid spills, electro-magnetic interference, radio-frequency interference, or any other risk identified by the TGRA;	The rule in its current form is indistinct, in that it does not provide full specifications to which standard(s) these types of tests are to be conducted to. We understand why the direct reference to UL was removed but it is recommended that the rule be supplemented to include a general reference as to the acceptability of internationally recognized laboratory testing. The TGRA approved independent testing laboratory shall then either perform this testing or shall inspect the submission for marks which indicate this testing has been performed by an appropriate laboratory.
547.16(c)	Odds notification. If the odds of hitting any advertised top prize exceeds 100 million to one, the Player Interface must continually display "Odds of winning the advertised top prize exceeds 100 million to one" or equivalent.	Please advise if this requirement applies to the top pattern or top prize. Ideally, the top prize would be defined within the requirements.
