Lance Vallo (Pueblo of Acoma) is the Phoenix Region Director at the National Indian Gaming Commission. As Region Director, he is responsible for the technical assistance, training and compliance at 54 Indian gaming facilities owned and operated by 33 federally recognized tribes located in Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico and southern Nevada.

Vallo became Phoenix Region Director in Nov. 2011. He joined the NIGC in May 1999 as a Field Investigator. Prior to joining the NIGC, he worked for the Pueblo of Acoma Gaming Commission from 1994 to 1999. Vallo served two years as the Commission's Vice Chair and three years as the Executive Director. He has received various awards and accolades during his time in Indian gaming.
