Classes will be presented by the NIGC Office of General Counsel, NIGC Compliance Division, Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). The training is appropriate for: tribal leaders, gaming commissioners, commission staff, operation managers and operations staff. This training is being presented at no charge.
