



**TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT:
REGIONAL TRAINING CONFERENCE
ROUTE 66 CASINO HOTEL

The National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC) is pleased to announce the Phoenix Regional Training Conference hosted by the Pueblo of Laguna. The training course topics will include regulation, compliance and enforcement of gaming regulations, as well as investigative technics. The presenters will include NIGC staff, Federal law enforcement and State gaming agents. There is **no cost to attend the training**, but attendees are responsible for their own lodging, travel and per diem expenses. This training is recommended for all tribal regulators, tribal officials, and casino management.

Location: Route 66 Casino Hotel. The Route 66 Casino Hotel is located at 14500 Central Ave., NW; I-40 @ Exit 140, Albuquerque, NM 87121.
