When the FBI Sections 11.01 Compact provides written permission under Section 11.01, Section 2.05 does not apply. Section 2.05 requires "the Authorized Recipient shall certify to the FBI Compact Officer that an audit was conducted with the Contractor within 90 days of the date the Contractor first receives CHRI under the approved outsourcing agreement." The FBI Compact Officer understands some TGRA have been unable to proceed with performing necessary equipment/system upgrades to ensure effective, efficient, and secure processing, as they have not received approval from the FBI Compact Officer to outsource the noncriminal justice administrative functions requiring access to criminal history record information.
