Dear Tribal Leader:

On behalf of the National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC), we are pleased to announce that we have submitted to the Federal Register correcting amendments to various NIGC regulations previously issued. These amendments are technical in nature and make no substantive changes to the NIGC regulations. We expect that the correcting amendments will be published in the Federal Register shortly, and they will become effective fifteen days after publication.

The amendments make a number of minor corrections to our regulations. As you know, the NIGC recently moved its headquarters. The correcting amendments update our regulations to reflect our new address. In addition, our existing regulations contain outdated references to previous regulations that no longer exist; in particular parts 524, 539, and 577. These parts were withdrawn in April, 2013 when the NIGC overhauled its appeals regulations and moved all appellate procedures to one subchapter (parts 580-585). Also, when the NIGC updated and revised several parts of its regulations a few years ago, it began replacing the word "Chairman" with "Chair." The NIGC now adds "Chair" to the definition of "Chairman" to make it clear the words have the same meaning. Finally, the amendments correct various minor grammatical errors.

The correcting amendments will be added to our website upon publication in the Federal Register. We will also ensure that the correct versions of our regulations are posted to the website as well.
