Jim McKee serves as the Acting Rapid City Region Director. As the Acting Rapid City Region Director McKee is responsible for the training, technical assistance, and compliance with the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act for 42 Indian Gaming operations and 22 gaming tribes across five states to include S.D., N.D., Mont., Wyo., and Neb..

McKee joined the NIGC in October of 2003 as a field investigator and later as a compliance officer. Prior to joining the NIGC, McKee began his career in the Gaming Industry in 1990 and served in numerous roles including Inspection, Compliance, Enforcement and as an Agent with the South Dakota Commission on Gaming.

McKee is a graduate of South Dakota State University with a Bachelor of Science degree.

The Indian Gaming Regulatory Act created the [National Indian Gaming Commission](#) to support tribal self-sufficiency and the integrity of Indian gaming. NIGC oversees the efficient regulation of more than 500 gaming establishments operated by 250 tribes across 29 states.
