## § 542.20 What is a Tier A gaming operation?

A Tier A gaming operation is one with annual gross gaming revenues of more than <u>\$2</u> \$1

million but not more than \$5 million.

**Justification:** In order to attain consistency in defining those gaming operations that are smaller than Tier A (small operations) and therefore may be exempt from many of the NIGC MICS requirements, it is recommended that the minimum threshold for Tier A be increased to "more than \$2 million."

**Comment** (March, 2010): Recommend that Tier A be changed to more than \$3 million but not more than \$8 million.

## Revised proposal as a result of March comment:

A Tier A gaming operation is one with annual gross gaming revenues of more than \$3 \$1

million but not more than <u>\$8</u> \$5 million.
