MANAGEMENT CONTRACT BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS

Subject: Instructions for the submission of required information including Standard Form 85P and Supplemental Information

Pursuant to National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC) regulations, 25 CFR Section 537 - BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS FOR PERSONS OR ENTITIES WITH A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN, OR HAVING MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITY FOR, A MANAGEMENT CONTRACT, the NIGC Chairman shall make a determination of suitability for a person with a financial interest in or having management responsibility for a management contract based upon a background investigation conducted for that purpose. In order to efficiently conduct an individual background investigation, it has been determined that the following documentation shall be submitted to the NIGC:

Standard Form 85P-Questionnaire For Public Trust Positions
Supplemental Information Pursuant To 25 CFR Section 537.1(b)(l)
Privacy Notice and Notice Regarding False Statements (2)
NIGC Authorization for Release of Information (2)
Fair Credit Reporting Act Release (2)
Fingerprints (2 Original Cards)
Form 8821-Tax Information Release (2) (Will be provided at commencement of Financial Background Investigation)

All questions and requested information shall be answered accurately and completely. If no response is necessary or applicable, please indicate by entering "None" or "NIA". Submit two (2) copies of each document -photocopies are acceptable as long as all pages contain original signatures and dates in black ink. (Fingerprint cards must be originals and completed cards must be received from an appropriate federal, state or tribal law enforcement agency. See § 537.1(b)(3).

In completing Standard Form 85P (SF 85P), please pay careful attention to the section "Instructions for Completing this Form" on the cover sheet. Some questions on the SF 85P specify a time frame of seven years, which is not consistent with 25 CFR Section 537.1 (b)(1). Therefore, in order to meet the standards of 25 CFR Section 537, the following questions should be answered for the timeframe indicated:

- 9. Residences: Provide ten (10) years of the information requested in this section. In addition, please provide the city, state and country of residence from age eighteen (18) to the present on the Supplemental Information form, Section (iii.)
- 11. Employment: Provide information for the past ten (10) years.
- 20. Police Record: In completing this section, please be sure to provide the following information pursuant to 25 CFR Section 537.1(b)(I):
 - (ix) For each gaming offense and for each felony for which there is an ongoing prosecution or a conviction, the name and address of the court involved, the charge, and the dates of the prosecution and the disposition; (Information for this section should be provided regardless of when the offense occurred.)
 - (x) For each misdemeanor conviction or ongoing misdemeanor prosecution (excluding minor traffic violations) within ten (10) years of the date of the application, the name and address for the court involved, and the dates of the prosecution and the disposition;
 - (xii) For each criminal charge, (excluding minor traffic charges) regardless of whether or not it resulted in a conviction, if such criminal charge is within ten (10) years of the date of the application and is not otherwise listed pursuant to paragraphs (b)(l)(ix) or (b)(l)(x) of this section, the name and address of the court involved, the criminal charge, and the dates of the charge and disposition;...]

It is not necessary to complete the "Authorization for Release of Medical Information." However, please be sure to complete the "Authorization for Release of Information".

In addition, please assure that a \$10,000 investigative fee deposit has been submitted to the NIGC for each individual for whom a background investigation will be conducted. A background investigation cannot be commenced until this deposit has been received.

Careful attention to the accurate and complete submission of all requested information and documentation will greatly expedite the background investigation process.

Failure to consent

to the disclosures indicated in this statement will mean that the Chairman of the National Indian Gaming Commission will be unable to approve the contract in which the person has a financial interest or management responsibility.

The disclosure of a person's Social Security Number (SSN) is voluntary. However, failure to supply a SSN may result in errors in processing the information provided.

A false statement knowingly and willfully provided in any of the information pursuant to this section may be grounds for not approving the contract in which I have a financial interest or management responsibility, or for disapproving or voiding such contract after it is approved by the Chairman of the National Indian Gaming Commission. Also, I may be punished by fine or imprisonment (U.S. Code, title 18, section 1001).
