The Red Lake Band supports the National Indian Gaming Commission's plan to draft updated, non-mandatory Class III MICS guidance for the Tribal Gaming industry. We believe that we will benefit by being informed by the NIGC's updated views on the spectrum of issues covered by the updated MICS.
