

RE: Comments on "Electronic One Touch Bingo System"

Dear Chairperson Stevens and Commissioner Little:

The Pawnee Nation Gaming Commission is writing this letter to let you know we agree with the Commission's proposal to "reinterpret the position regarding one touch bingo".

As was echoed by all in attendance at the consultation recently held at the Oklahoma Indian Gaming Conference in Oklahoma City, one touch bingo is a Class II game and that the one touch auto-daub is consistent with the IGRA definition of Bingo. We believe that advances in technology should not hinder the determination that the game is a live bingo game that is taking place across a linked network of actual players.

The Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma is pleased that the Commission has decided to clarify that a game that is otherwise Class II bingo is not converted into a Class III game through the addition of the one touch auto daub feature.
