## **NIGC to Offer Training in Louisiana**

Washington, DC December 3, 2010 — The National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC) is offering "Regulating Gaming Technology" training on December 14-16, 2010 at the Coshatta Casino Resort's Coshatta Grand Hotel in Kinder, Louisiana.

This comprehensive 3-day training will assist tribal leaders, tribal gaming regulatory authorities and casino compliance personnel in understanding basic gaming technologies needed to effectively regulate technology on the casino floor.
