NEW! Updated Regulating Gaming Technology (RGT) Course

A 12-hour training track dedicated to Gaming Technology is being offered over two days.

Course Purpose: The Regulating Gaming Technology Course will provide instruction central to understanding the unique gaming machine technology structure and the importance of close monitoring and compliance in the success of the casino meeting requirements. The course is designed for novice and veteran staff.

Topics include: Auditing 543, Refining and Enhancing your IT TICS , A fresh look at EGM & Progressives, System Verification & Game Authentication Tool, IT Threats for Casinos, IT Threats for Casinos, Gaming Forensics

NEW! Virtual attendance through Adobe Connect

The NIGC is continuing to take strides in meeting the Commission's initiative of staying ahead of the technology curve and creating a strong workforce. To accommodate all of our regulatory partners and Tribal leader's ability to access training, you can attend courses virtually.

All the courses will be broadcasted from the St. Paul Regulating Gaming Technology event through a virtual classroom using Adobe Connect. Prior individual registration is required to receive access to the classroom link. Registration can be completed using the virtual training tab on our NIGC website.
