



PAY.GOV: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA) REQUEST E-PAYMENT PROCESS INSTRUCTIONS

The National Indian Gaming Commission FOIA Payment Form is a PUBLIC FORM. Public forms are freely available to everyone. It is not necessary to self-enroll to make a payment using a public form. **However**, by self-enrolling and creating an account with Pay.gov, you can:

- See the payments you have made since you created an account
- Store payment information so you do not have to re-enter it
- Copy a form you already submitted the next time you need to make a payment

If you would like to have a record of the payments that you submit online, you should register and create an account.

1. Go to www.pay.gov, and type "NIGC" in the search field, then click on the magnifying glass to initiate a search. Click on "**Continue**" Under the "Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Payment Form-NIGC" section. You may create an account if you prefer or click on "**Continue to the Form**" to reach the "Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Payment Form-NIGC".
2. Enter the information as indicated. Fields marked with a red asterisk (*) are mandatory; the form will not process if you do not provide complete and correct information.
In the "Amount Due to the National Indian Gaming Commission" field, enter the amount owed for processing costs associated with the FOIA request.
3. Once you complete the form, click "**Continue**" to go to the next step in the payment process where you will need to provide your bank information as requested.
